



Occupational Medicine Symposium

The basic course on the practice of routine occupational medicine in the US Air Force, intended for physicians relatively new to flight medicine and family medicine practitioners (physicians and physician assistants) who see occupational medicine patients as part of their practice. On a space-available basis, the course will be open to nurses and independent duty medical technicians. Topics covered in the course will include various clinical situations frequently encountered in occupational medicine, common occupational hazards along with their epidemiology, pathophysiology, surveillance, clinic administration issues, and information on broader system issues relevant to practicing occupational medicine in the Air Force.

Students must bring the following items:

- a signed DD 2875 (SAAR) completed within 60 days
- a completed AF 4394 (User's Agreement)
- a current IA training certificate

Note: Students should contact their security office upon receipt of their training notification to obtain these documents.

Active Duty (AD) commissioned officers: Assigned to Expeditionary Medical Support (EMEDS) Unit Type Code

AD enlisted personnel: Assigned to Expeditionary Medical Support (EMEDS) Unit Type Codes

Health workers: With at least occasional involvement with occupational medicine
