



Medical Personnel Reliability Program (PRP) Workshop

The Medical Personnel Reliability Program (PRP) Workshop is designed to accomplish required training that will enable the student to competently perform the full spectrum of duties in support of program objectives. It provides the required knowledge and skills to appropriately manage the medical components of PRP.

It is a combination of didactic and hands-on training that includes a program overview, the impact of medical conditions on ability/reliability, and recognition of Potentially Disqualifying Information (PDI) as well as documentation and reporting. Also included is the management of suspension and decertification recommendations as well as the process of returning a member to PRP status.

Attendees who successfully complete this workshop will be certified by the AFMS to assume or continue to perform the duties of Lead Competent Medical Authority (CMA) or Lead Medical PRP Monitor (4A0X1 as Primary AFSC).

This workshop is mandatory for SGPs/Lead PRP/Presidential Support Program (PSP) monitors from all Medical Groups (including those that only perform PRP qualification reviews) and medical PRP inspectors. It is also mandatory for the primary CMAs from all installations with assigned PRP-certified personnel.

Medical personnel working in stand-alone PRP clinics and medical personnel who are directly supporting PRP at MAJCOMS and supporting agencies are highly encouraged to attend on a space available basis. The lead CMA and the lead PRP monitor are responsible for the training of the rest of the medical group per AFMAN 10-3902.
