

## **Survival, Evasion, Resistance and Escape (SERE)**

**\*\*no longer part of the formal USAFSAM AMP curriculum\*\***

SERE is no longer part of the formal USAFSAM AMP curriculum and is not required for graduation or for the award of Wings.

**However, SERE (SV-80A) at Fairchild AFB, WA is an aircrew requirement, and therefore is a requirement for all 48XXs filling an active flight surgeon billet.** S-V80-A SERE is conducted at Fairchild AFB, WA and begins every Monday, 50 weeks of each year and runs for 19 consecutive training days.

Please be advised, aircraft-specific (parachute vs. non-parachute) water survival is also required and is scheduled as a separate course.

AMP graduates should coordinate specific SERE requirements with their unit's Chief of Aerospace Medicine (SGP). Requests for training enrollment should be approved by the unit Commander and requested through the Unit Training Manager.
