- b. Set environmental goals, measure progress, take corrective action when necessary to address actual or potential noncompliance situations, and communicate information regarding the installation's environmental accomplishments to workers, regulators, and the public.
- c. Establish and implement an effective pollution prevention program, minimize the generation of waste, recycle materials to prevent waste when possible, and dispose of any remaining waste in an environmentally responsible manner.
- d. Ensure responsible use of energy throughout the installation; include the adoption of innovative practices and procedures to conserve energy and improve efficiency.
