SUMMARY

- PURPOSE.** To provide Air Mobility Command (AMC) with a C-130J Safe-to-Fly (STF) recommendation for the Verathon Ranger Glidescope Video Laryngoscope System hereon referred to as the Glidescope.
- BACKGROUND.** The Glidescope is a portable video system for ensuring the larynx is unobstructed and properly placing an airway tube. The Glidescope was tested for airworthiness per the United States Air Force (USAF) Aeromedical Equipment STF protocols.
- LIMITATIONS.** None; although, when not in use, the Glidescope should be properly stowed and/or secured during take-offs and landings.
- VIEW OF OTHERS.** N/A
- RECOMMENDATION.** The Tactical Airlift Division recommends releasing the Glidescope as STF on the C-130J and WC-130J fleet. In order to preserve this safety of flight approval, alterations, configuration changes or modifications to the system/aircraft are prohibited without prior approval of the Tactical Airlift Division. If the units require C-130J technical assistance at any time after the subject capability is fielded, they are to use the USAF Automated Inspection, Repair, Corrosion & Aircraft Tracking System at <https://c130aircat.robins.af.mil>.
