SUBJECT: Safe-to-Fly Certification for the Backpack Medical Oxygen System (BMOS).

1. Based on the review of the provided data, Safe-to-Fly Certification for the Backpack Medical Oxygen System (BMOS) is approved for use on C-130E/H, non-refueling, non-fuselage fuel carrying aircraft.
