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SUMMARY

- PURPOSE.** Provide Air Mobility Command (AMC) with an interim C-130J STF recommendation for the Physio-Control Inc. Lifepak 1000 AED (Lifepak 1000 AED).
- BACKGROUND.** The Lifepak 1000 AED is completely self-contained and weighs only 7.1 pounds. The Lifepak 1000 AED went through electromagnetic interference (EMI), explosive atmosphere, and acceleration testing to support a safety of flight decision. The Lifepak 1000 AED passed all testing. C-130J engineering (ASC/WLNNA) has reviewed the Lifepak 1000 AED system and the test data and has no safety of flight concerns.
- DISCUSSION.** The Lifepak 1000 AED is suitable for use on the C-130J aircraft with the stipulation that the Lifepak 1000 AED will be stored in the medic's equipment bag when not in use and tied down when in use.
- VIEW OF OTHERS.** N/A.
- RECOMMENDATION.** Tactical Airlift Division recommends releasing the Lifepak 1000 AED as STF on the C-130J fleet with the stipulation mentioned in paragraph 3 above.
