SUBJECT: KC-10 Safe-To-Fly (STF) Approval for the Telephonics TruLink Portable  
Transceiver

References: Memorandum from 77 AESG/CC dated 11 Jun 09  
Test Report No. FY09.003 for Subject Equipment

1. The KC-10 System Program Office has reviewed the test results for the Telephonics TruLink Portable Transceiver and approve the use of subject equipment for all phases of flight on the KC-10 aircraft. This approval is based on satisfactory results from the performance baseline, vibration, humidity, altitude, rapid decompression, explosive atmosphere, and acceleration tests.
2. If the transceiver is in use but is not being carried by personnel, ensure that the placement of the transceiver's antenna maintains a distance of 20 cm/8 in from aircraft cable connectors and avionics equipment.
3. This approval is contingent upon the transceiver being shut off when not in use.
4. We also recommend that the specific part number and specifications be incorporated into the current Aeromedical Evacuation command guidance.
