- Relocate the Space Vehicles Directorate from Hanscom AFB to Kirtland Air Force Base, NM, not later than (NLT) 15 Sep 2011*
- Relocate the Sensors Directorate from Hanscom AFB to Wright-Patterson AFB, OH, NLT 15 Sep 2011*
- Relocate the Sensor Directorate from the Air Force Research Lab at Rome, NY, to Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, OH, NLT 15 Sep 2011 and consolidate it with the Air Force Research Laboratory, Sensor Directorate*
- Relocate the Information Systems Directorate of the Air Force Research Laboratory from Wright-Patterson AFB to Rome Laboratory, NY, NLT 15 Sep 2011*
- Wright-Patterson AFB receives the Naval Aeromedical Research Laboratory from Naval Air Station Pensacola, FL, NLT 15 Sep 2011*
- Wright-Patterson AFB receives the United States Air Force School of Aerospace Medicine, the Air Force Institute of Operational Health, and the Human Systems Development and Acquisition function from the closure of Brooks City Base, San Antonio, TX, NLT 15 Sep 2011*
- Consolidate at Wright-Patterson AFB the Human Effectiveness Directorate with the Air Force Research Laboratory, Human Effectiveness Directorate from the closure of Brooks City-Base, San Antonio, TX, NLT 15 Sep 2011*
- Relocate the Directed Energy portion of the Human Effectiveness Directorate of the Air Force Research Laboratory to Fort Sam Houston, TX, NLT 15 Sep 2011*
- Wright-Patterson AFB receives all Air Force Research Laboratory functions from Mesa City, AZ, NLT 15 Sep 2011*
- Wright-Patterson AFB receives the physiological training unit (49 ADOS/SGGT) from the disestablished high-onset gravitational force centrifuge at Holloman AFB NLT 15 Sep 2011”*
