Lieutenant Colonel Kenric L. Phillips is the Director of Staff, Air Force Installation Contracting Center, Air Force Installation and Mission Support Center, Air Force Materiel Command, Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Ohio. Lt Col Phillips is the lead for all staff members supporting and 810 personnel agency with a total contract portfolio of \$33 billion. He oversees a team of 87 officers, enlisted and civilian personnel which coordinates the agency workflow, policies, procedures, resources, and directives for all of AFICC. Additionally, he heads the team responsible for finding strategic sourcing opportunities with the Air Force. His staff support extends across 8 Major Commands with combined annual obligations of \$3.9 billion.

Lt Col Phillips first enlisted into military service in 1991 through the Army as a Combat Medic (91B). He later commissioned into the Air Force through the Officer Training School (OTS) in 2000. He has served at various levels in Operational, Major Weapons Systems, Test and Evaluation, Research and Development, Space and Missile Systems, Command, and Joint Staff contracting roles.
