## U.S. Air Force Fact Sheet AFICA/KC

AFICA/KC, is an Operating Location of the Air Force Installation Contracting Agency (AFICA), a subordinate unit of Air Force Installation and Mission Support Center (AFIMSC). Located at Joint Base Langley-Eustis (JBLE), Virginia; AFICA/KC is designated as the on-site contracting staff and execution capability for Air Combat Command (ACC) to support customer requirements. AFICA/KC provides contract clearance, guidance, and policy oversight to ACC's \$3B portfolio executed across 14 operational contracting squadrons, United States Air Force Central Command (CENTCOM), and the U.S. Military training mission in Saudi Arabia.

AFICA/KC also provides force development for 580 military and civilian contracting professionals in staff, center, and wing units, while leading re-organizations, lean projects, transformation efforts, and the contracting officer warrant board training program.

### **Core Mission:**

- Provide business advice to the Air Combat Command (ACC) Commander
- Provide acquisition oversight and contract clearance for ACC contracting units
- Develop, train and retain a capable Air Force Contracting Corps, ready to meet ACC's Contracting mission

**Background:**

In July 2010, the Office of the Secretary of Defense (OSD) directed each Service to gain efficiencies and reduce operational costs. As part of this plan, Air Force Contracting established a Headquarters Air Force level Field Operating Agency (HAF-FOA) on 1 October 2013, to manage and execute above-wing operational contracting including enterprise and strategic sourcing. This FOA, called the Air Force Installation Contracting Agency (AFICA), located at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base (WPAFB), OH; realigned operational contracting staff functions and contracting resources at above-wing contracting execution organizations while maintaining the wing-level “One Wing, One Boss” installation support concept.

In addition to Enterprise Sourcing Squadrons (ESSs), Specialized Contracting Squadrons (SCONs), and Contracting Squadrons (CONs); these Operation Locations (OLs) exist worldwide. There are eight OLs within AFICA.
