New Parent Support Program - The New Parent Support Program is an all-encompassing plan to provide support and education to military families in the prenatal period and during the first three years postpartum. The program is designed as a non-threatening method to provide basic services on parenting attitudes and serve as a means to identify parents at risk and provide support to those parents via home visits. It is also recognized as a child abuse prevention program which provide parents with the knowledge needed to encourage optimum brain development during the critical early years.

Services offered include: Parenting Education; Child Development Education; "What to Expect" Book Series; Educational videos and materials; Handouts on various topics; Informal groups; Supportive Community Based Services; Home visits; Office visits; Phone Consultations.

New Parent/Baby Care Workshop classes are offered twice per year.
