ROCKET BUILD SUPPORT

Building 2: 9:00 am–3:30 pm

Total Volunteers Needed: 25

Event takes place from 10:00 am–3:00 pm

Rocket Building Assistants: 22 volunteers needed

- Attend a brief training session (9:00–9:40 am) and build a sample rocket
- Help kids and families build rockets at designated tables

Rocket Kit Distribution & Seating Guides: 3 volunteers needed

- Guide participants to their build tables in building 2
- Distribute rocket kits to participants
- If you attend the rocket build training session you can fill-in for those needing breaks

Total Volunteers Needed: 5

Assist visitors with hands-on STEM activities in Building 4, including:

- Bernoulli Shooter Station
